Question regarding the specific job scheduling. :) Is it possible to trigger project or job plan execution just right after the RD server starts?

What is it necessary for: if host server restarts (due to technical problems, maintenance or any other reason) and RD server starts working, I'd like it to execute some system checks. I mean, RD should check other services, that should be running on the same server, redeploy and/or reconfigure those if necessary.

Hi Vadim,

When the RD instance is restarted, if some jobs were running before instance shutdown, they will be cancelled on start up. The only ones still available it will be the scheduled jobs. You can set them to run for a certain date/time or make it recurrent to run hourly, dialy or weekly.

I hope I cleared your doubts.
